You will make a poster that depicts a safety rule and the consequences of NOT following it. Keep in mind this is an individual assignment! You may get ideas and suggestions from your group members but you must complete the poster by yourself. This safety poster may have words written on it and must clearly depict the safety rule. Your science teacher will display posters around the room as reminders to students during future laboratory investigations of the safety rules. Please make sure they are easily seen. Be creative and colorful!

Students will use a white sheet of paper for their posters and include information to explain their safety rule on the poster.
